

Ecojustice funding breakdown: Donations from U.S. sources earmarked for tar sands work

This chart tracks donations from 2010 to 2018.

Prior to that time period, Ecojustice used a different method for categorizing where gifts came from and how the organization intended to use them. Donation totals for 2019 (the 2018-2019 fiscal year) have yet to be finalized.
