



### Climate plan

- Mandated by ss. 9(1) and due *at least* 5 years before beginning of the relevant milestone year per s. 9(4)
- Plan for 2030 target due no later than March 29, 2021 per ss. 9(2) and (3)
- Plan must include 2026 interim objective per s. 9(2.1)
- Plan requirements set out in s. 10
- Minister must take UNDRIP into account (s. 9(5)), consult relevant federal ministers (s. 12) and provide for public participation (s. 13) when creating plan
- Minister must publish public participation report per s. 13.1 - no deadline
- Minister must table Climate Plan in House within first 15 days of sitting after plan established per s. 18(1) and make public soon after per s. 19(1)

### Annual Net Zero Advisory Board (NZAB) Report

- Per s. 22(1), made public within 30 days per s.22(2)

### NZAB Advice

- Per s. 20(1)

### Minister's Response to NZAB Annual Report

- Due within 120 days of receipt of report per s.22(2)

### Minister of Finance Annual Report

- Per s. 23 [not yet in force]

### Progress Reports

- Due end 2023, end 2025, end 2027 per s. 14(1.1)
- Thereafter every five years: by end 2032, end 2037, end 2042, end 2047 per s. 14(1)
- 2025 progress report to include assessment of 2030 target per s. 14(1.2). Minister must consider whether 2030 target should be changed.
- Progress report requirements at s. 14(2)&(3)
- Minister must table reports in House within first 15 days of sitting after report finalized per s. 18(3) and make public soon after per s. 19(3)

### Targets for Milestone Years

- Set for 2030, 2035, 2040 and 2045 per s. 7(1)
- Targets for 2035, 2040 and 2045 set ten yrs in advance per s. 7(4)
- High-level description of measures to meet milestone targets 2035, 2040 and 2045 (including latest emissions projections) due within one year of setting per s. 7(5)

### Reports of the Commissioner of Environment and Sustainable Development (CESD)

- Mandated to examine and report on implementation of mitigation measures at least every five yrs.
- First report due no later than end of 2024 per s. 24(4)

### Review of Act

- Five years after coming in to force, comprehensive review (s. 27.1)
- First review undertaken by June 2026
